This week we are going to be...

continuing to develop the children's scientific skills by carrying out an experiment with carnations in coloured water. The children will be asked to predict what they think will happen to the flowers placed in different coloured water and encouraged to check on them throughout the week to see if any changes can be noted. If anything does happen to the carnations, the children will hopefully give reasons as to why the changes have occurred.

As part of Expressive Arts and Design and to develop listening skills and fine motor control, there will be a group activity around children copying different rhythms that adults play for them. This can be carried out at home through clapping games. Those children able to follow any patterns will be asked to come up with some of their own for their friends to copy.

There is not too long now until the Easter holiday so we see this as a good point of the term for the children to take a look through their Learning Journals and reflect on some of the activities and learning they have done while they have been in the Nursery.

Quite a bit of clothing has gone missing over the past few weeks. Though most children's clothing is named, they can become faint and difficult to read or labels fall out. Could you check that your child's name can still be read clearly and see if they've inadvertently brought home someone else's clothing. Some fleeces have the name labels inside pockets.
