UNIFORM POLICY

All uniform must be named

Boys

- ✚ White collared shirt or polo shirt (all tops to be tucked in at all times)
- ✚ Grey trousers or tailored knee-length shorts
- ✚ Navy blue **long sleeved jumper**/sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan with school badge (either sewn on/ironed on pre- embroidered)
- ✚ Plain black shoes/sandals/trainers - no logos/patterns/stripes etc - no boots.
Wellingtons can be worn in inclement weather but a change of shoes should be provided
- ✚ White, grey or black socks
- ✚ Nursery children need to have a pair of wellingtons for outdoor play

Girls

- ✚ White collared blouse or polo shirt (all tops to be tucked in at all times, unless the blouse is a fitted one)
- ✚ Grey trousers or tailored knee-length shorts
- ✚ Grey knee length skirt or pinafore dress (plain or with simple pleats only)
- ✚ In hot weather, girls can wear blue and white checked dresses or blue and white checked matching blouse and skirt set which look like a dress (ie. not checked tops with plain grey skirt or plain white tops with checked skirts)
- ✚ Navy blue **long sleeved jumper**/sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan with school badge (either sewn on/ironed on pre- embroidered)
- ✚ Plain black shoes/sandals/trainers - no logos/patterns/stripes etc - no boots.
Wellingtons can be worn in inclement weather but a change of shoes should be provided
- ✚ White, grey or black socks (white ankle socks with pale blue/white checked frilled trim may be worn during summer months). Woollen tights can be worn in cold weather.
- ✚ Nursery children need to have a pair of wellingtons for outdoor play

PLEASE NOTE: NO SHORTS TO BE WORN WITH TIGHTS - THIS IS INAPPROPRIATE SCHOOL ATTIRE.

PE Kit

- ✚ Pale blue t-shirt or polo shirt with school badge (either sewn on/ironed on pre- embroidered)
- ✚ Navy shorts
- ✚ White, grey or black socks.
- ✚ Navy Tracksuit bottoms for cold weather
- ✚ Black or white trainers or black plimsolls

Accessories, hair and makeup etc

- ✚ No jewellery or accessories to be worn in school with the exception of Watches, Fitbits and plain stud earrings. ALL EARRINGS MUST BE REMOVED OR TAPED FOR PE
- ✚ No nail varnish
- ✚ No make up
- ✚ No tattoos - transfers or henna. For any cultural events where henna tattoos are part of the celebration, please contact the office
- ✚ Long hair must be tied back
- ✚ All hairbands should be plain navy/cream/white or blue/white checked - NO BRAIDS, NO JO JO BANDS OR OVERSIZED BOWS.
- ✚ No multi-coloured headscarves or accessories
- ✚ No patterns or tramlines to be shaved into hair
- ✚ No Mohican hairstyles
- ✚ No artificially dyed hair

Bags

- ✚ All bags must be an official Lodge Farm Bag - Book Bag, PE Bag or Back Pack

Parents will be contacted if we notice the uniform policy is not being followed.

**Please note that whilst consideration has been given to the wearing of Tank Tops, we have made the decision that tank tops will NOT be part of our school uniform. We have streamlined our new uniform policy to limit the choice as per consultation with the parents involved with the Parents' Forum. Our new streamlined uniform policy will make it easier for us to monitor school uniform standards and make it clearer for parents. If we allow tank tops, we feel we are paving the way for other variations too. Jumpers/Sweatshirts and Fleeces etc must all be long-sleeved.*
